Dear Sir or Madam,

We confirm that the used raw material components in our coating, ink and adhesive systems correspond to the requirements of the European Inventory of Existing Chemicals (EINECS), "EuPIA Exclusion Policy for Printing Inks and Related Products" and REACH Regulation (EC) No 1907/2006. Within the meaning of the REACH Regulation (EC) No 1907/2006 the WEILBURGER Graphics GmbH is downstream user and is legally not obligated for registration of raw materials. Our suppliers provide us with REACH conform raw materials. Therefore we can confirm that the coating, ink and adhesive systems produced by the WEILBURGER Graphics GmbH are compliant with the REACH Regulation (EC) No 1907/2006.

According to our level of awareness SVHC substances, published by ECHA in the candidate list of "Substances of Very High Concern" (<http://echa.europa.eu/en/candidate-list-table>) on 12 January 2017, are not a constitutional part with a concentration of > 0,1 % in the coating, ink and adhesive systems of the WEILBURGER Graphics GmbH and therefore the compliance with the REACH Regulation (EC) No 1907/2006 is given. Furthermore, forbidden or restricted substances related to Annex XVII of the REACH Regulation (EC) No 1907/2006 are not part of our products.

The European Standard for toys EN 71-3:2013 restricts the amount of certain elements as aluminium, antimony, arsenic, barium, lead, boron, cadmium, chromium, cobalt, copper, nickel, organo tin, manganese, mercury, selenium, strontium, zinc and tin in toys. Basically, we can declare that the critical values of the above mentioned heavy metals are not exceeded with our coating and adhesive products.
